**FINAL ORDER  
REVOKING CANADIAN CHARTER AIR TAXI REGISTRATION**

By Order 2007-2-20, issued February 21, 2007, we directed all interested persons to show cause why we should not make final our tentative findings and conclusions revoking the Canadian charter air taxi registration of Flight-Ops International, Inc., d/b/a SkyXpress Airline on the grounds that the carrier's Federal Aviation Administration operations specifications were terminated. Interested persons were given 14 calendar days to file objections to the order. No objections to the show cause order were filed.

**ACCORDINGLY:**

1. We find that Flight-Ops International, Inc., d/b/a Skyxpress Airline no longer holds effective Federal Aviation Administration operations specifications.
2. Pursuant to 14 CFR 294.50(h), we revoke the air taxi registration of Flight-Ops International, Inc., d/b/a Skyxpress Airline.
